PRESS RELEASE

Sheriff Greg Speck reports that a Somerset woman was arrested Tuesday, September 17, 2019 following a traffic stop on Monticello Street in Somerset, Kentucky.

At approximately 4:06 pm Tuesday afternoon, Deputy Steven Alexander observed a 2000 Nissan Maxima on Monticello Street with expired registration plates. Deputy Alexander conducted a traffic stop at the intersection of Monticello Street and Hope Way where he made contact with the operator of the vehicle, Destiny Owens, age 22 of Boat Dock Road, Somerset, Kentucky.

After checking with the 911 Dispatch Center, the Deputy learned that Ms. Owens was being sought on 4 outstanding warrants from Pulaski County.

Deputy Alexander placed Destiny Owens under arrest for the outstanding warrants.

Two small baggies containing a crystalline substance consistent with methamphetamine, a baggie containing a 10 mg. Oxycodone tablet, and a small baggie of marijuana were found on the subject at the time of the arrest.

Destiny Owens was charged with the following:

1. No Registration Plate
2. No Registration Receipt
3. Failure to Produce Insurance Card
4. Failure of Non-Owner Operator to Maintain Required Insurance, 1st Offense
5. Operating on Suspended or Revoked Operators License
6. Possession of Controlled Substance 1st Degree, 1st Offense (Methamphetamine)
7. Possession of Controlled Substance 1st Degree, 1st Offense (Drug Unspecified)
8. Possession of Marijuana
